Guidelines for Poster Presentations

During the Poster Session:

The presenting author is expected to orally explain their work to interested attendees. Your poster should begin with a header that includes the title, followed by the names of the authors and their organizational affiliations. The poster should be organized into the following sections:

Problem Definition and Objectives: Provide a brief introduction to the problem and a concise statement of the research objectives.

Methodology: Describe the methods used to achieve the research objectives, emphasizing any novel theoretical or experimental approaches.

Results: Present your research findings using appropriate tables and graphs.

Conclusions: Summarize the conclusions and their significance.

References: List only the most critical references to allocate sufficient space for the main sections.

Acknowledgements: Keep this section brief, limited to one or two sentences.

Set-Up Details:

The maximum poster size is 190 cm (height) × 90 cm (width). This size limit applies to all posters. Each poster board will have a designated paper number corresponding to the number listed in the program booklet. Supplies such as mounting pins and tape will be provided.

Session Time and Date:

Posters should be set up any time before 18:00 on Tuesday, 8 October 2024. The poster session will take place on Tuesday, 8 October 2024, from 18:15 to 19:30. Authors are expected to remain with their posters for the duration of the session. Posters will be available during the whole duration of the symposium.

Best Poster Awards:

The best 3 Posters will be awarded, and the authors will have the opportunity to give a flash presentation (5 minutes presentation + 2 minutes questions) during the Symposium. The awards will be announced on Wednesday, 9 October 2024, and the flash oral presentation will be given on Thursday, 10 October 2024.
